Russell Hedrick is a first-generation farmer using new technologies and cover crops to reduce applied inputs and maximize yields. Russell was awarded the 2014 North Carolina Innovative Young Farmer of the Year and has been a featured producer in the *Farm Press* magazine for maximizing his cover crop benefits by mixing species and national *No-till Farmer* for integration of cattle onto covers and the Haney test for reducing fertilizer inputs on cash crops.



David Brandt began no-till farming in 1971 and has been using cover crops since 1978. His recent work has been planting various blends of cover crops to find out what benefits they provide to improve soil. At present David is working with Ohio State University on reducing input costs of fertilizers and herbicides using various cover crops, which improve soil health.



The Dresbach Family Farm is focused on regenerative agriculture practices and supplying our neighbors with our local homegrown non-GMO products. We work hard to farm in a sustainable and holistic way that promotes nutrient rich products. The Dresbach Family is widely known for their diversified multigenerational Farm and use of Compost Tea and Extract for crop fertility and Health.



DeAnna and Kelly Lozensky made a foundational change away from synthetic inputs on their North Dakota farm in 2019 and have not looked back. Using the Indigenous Micro Organism (IMO) from their own farm they have developed their own fertility system to improve crop health, nutrient content and maintain yield – significantly improving not only their quality of life but profitability as well!
